This will also have an effect on all content areas to improve student learning during the 2019-20 school year. We will also provide after school tutoring in Math, Science, and English. We will hire a Social Worker to share between Fremont, Rocky Mountain, and Wahlquist. This will allow students to receive crucial mental services. According to Maslow's hierarchy of needs, students cannot function in school until their basic needs are met. We will hire 2 half-day substitutes that will work in classes when substitute teachers are not available. This will make it possible for teachers to use their preparation time to prepare for instruction and not to cover classes that are not filled by substitutes. These aides will also work with our student advocate and options aides to provide needed support services.
