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1. Classroom Expectations

In studying, applying, and exploring the information for this class, students are expected to behave in a manner enabling learning as a professional, productive member of the group. Students are expected to respect the rights of the teacher to teach, students to learn, and the school's property and equipment used in those processes. Responsibility will be placed on any individual found to be acting in a manner contrary to those listed.

2. Class Rules

3. You will get your materials from your locker, go to the restroom, and get a drink of water before you report to class, so hall passes will not be necessary.

5. Students will behave as a professional--just as they would if they were at work. Any student found to be taking, giving away, or selling merchandise at a reduced price, OR taking money from the store will be removed from the course and possibly referred to the authorities for prosecution.

3. Grading

Grades will be based on activities, assignments and participation in the class. Attendance is very crucial. The grading scale is as follows:

4. Absenses
