**Objectives:** Students will be learning the state core pre-algebra objectives using the SAXON Math program, which develops math skills and concepts, mental math reasoning, and problem solving skills. Students will be taking the state core test at the end of the school year.

**Materials:** Students are expected to come to class prepared with a positive attitude, paper, and a pencil. Each student will be provided a folder, calculator, and textbook which they will be expected to keep in the classroom and in excellent condition.

**Grading:**

90 – 100 = A    80 – 89 = B    79 – 70 = C    60 – 69 = D    59 or below = F

**Citizenship:** Students are expected to follow school, district, and classroom rules in order to allow the teacher the right to teach and all students the right to learn. Two things will affect citizenship: tardies and class behavior. Repeated inappropriate behaviors will be handled according to Wahlquist Junior High School policy.

**Inappropriate behaviors repeated over time:**

**1<sup>st</sup> offense:**      Warning  
**2<sup>nd</sup> offense:**    Student/teacher conference  
**3<sup>rd</sup> offense:**    Phone call to parent  
**4<sup>th</sup> offense:**    “N” citizenship grade and phone call to parent  
**5<sup>th</sup> offense:**    “U” citizenship grade and meeting with parent

**Tardies (according to school policy)**

**3<sup>rd</sup> tardy:** “N” citizenship grade  
**4<sup>th</sup> tardy:** “U” citizenship grade

**Interventions for inappropriate behaviors exhibited during a particular class period may include:**

- Warning
- Student/teacher conference after class
- Think time
- Lunch with teacher
- Phone call to parent
- Behavior Intervention Plan
- Office referral
